The students will meet at McGuire Middle School on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15pm to 4:45pm. The 1st meeting will be on Tuesday the 13th of April, and the final meeting of the season will be on Thursday May 27th. Students who attend KTMS or CMS can ride the activities bus to McGuire, but arrangements for a ride home must be made outside of the school transportation activities bus. There will be an Adult on Site who represents ISD 194 taking attendance and ensuring COVID-19 protocols are being followed. There will also be two coaches, 1 Male and 1 Female, provided by the Lakeville North High School Varsity Ultimate Team (The Crayons).

Until otherwise directed by ISD 194 and the MN Dept of Health, we will remain in compliance with COVID-19 recommendations for safety. Attendance is required, masks will be required, social distancing will be required and we ask that students do not share water or snacks.
