The golf team is for 6th-8th grade boys and girls. All skill levels are welcome and our coaches will work with students to improve the player's overall game.

Practices start Tuesday April 9 at Cleary Lake GC. Practices are M.-F. from approximately 3:15-5:00 p.m. Golfers will take a shuttle bus to Cleary, parents will pick golfers up at Cleary after practice.

We will have three teams of equal numbers of golfers, Century, Kenwood, McGuire. Each team will be capped at 20 golfers. Golfers should bring tennis or golf shoes, rain gear and must have their own golf clubs and transport them to school each morning. **Clubs cannot be taken on the route buses. They will be stored at a designated spot at each middle school.**

If you are trying out for High School, you must register for both the middle school and the HS teams, there will be no spot held.

6th - 8th grade Track and Field serves as an introduction to the sport. Regardless of athletic ability, there is an event for every athlete. We offer 8 events on the track and 4 in the field. Practices will start on Tuesday April 9.

There will be two track teams, one that feeds LNHS and one that feeds LSHS. There will be two separate schedules, one for each team. The CMS/KTMS (north) team will practice at Kenwood M.-F. from 2:15-3:45. The KTMS/MMS (south) team will practice after school at McGuire M.-F. from 3:00-4:30.

Century students will take the shuttle bus after school to Kenwood. Kenwood South students will take the shuttle bus after school to McGuire.

Because of limited court space, participation will be first come, first serve. You must complete registration on Rschool Today before the start of the season.

Practices are Monday – Friday starting on Tuesday April 9, right after school for about 1-1/2 hours. CMS and KTMS will start practice by 2:15, MMS by 3:00. The goals of this group are to improve tennis skills, compete against other schools, have fun and exercise. Tennis is for boys in 6-8 grade.

Athletes should bring a tennis racquet and wear tennis attire the first day.

7th and 8th graders, with tennis experience may try out for the varsity teams at the high schools. Contact the high schools for tryout information and requirements prior to our middle school season. If you are trying out for High School, you must register for both the middle school and the HS teams, there will be no spot held.

If there is not a date listed in your child's health tab, there is not one on record at school. Please submit an updated sports physical to your child's school.
