PSAT SCORES RELEASED

PSAT/NMSQT scores for anyone who took the voluntary exam at Lakeville South, on Saturday, Oct 15th, have now been released online to all Minnesota students. If you provided your email address on your answer sheet on test day, you should have received an email notifying you that scores are available. The email will have a unique access code that will connect you to your scores online. If you didn't provide an email address on your answer sheet on test day, you can still access your scores online. If you haven't already done so, you'll be asked to set up a free [College Board account](#) before you can view your scores. **If you've registered for AP exams, you should already have an account that way, too. Contact College Board's HELP option if you have any problems.**

VISITOR SCHEDULE
