## HIGH SCHOOL PAGE PROGRAM

**DEADLINE is TODAY, Friday, November 18th** if you want to be part of the High School Page Program which has been dedicated to providing participants with hands-on access to our state government in action. **The program is open to MN high school JUNIORS.** Modeled after the U.S Congress Page Program, the MN House of Representatives program is dedicated to providing students with meaningful opportunities and has evolved into one of the top page programs in the nation. Throughout the course of their week in Saint Paul, participants are exposed to a wide variety of experiences, designed to provide them with a deep understanding of our state government.

Participants are selected in the fall of each year to have a chance as a page in the Jan-May session(s) based on a formal process which includes an application, faculty recommendation, and an essay.
