EXTENDED DEADLINE for AP EXAMS

The initial deadline for ordering any full year or 1st semester AP exam was this past Friday. The Infinite Campus portal has re-opened AP exams for late payment on registrations for an additional \$20 (now \$95 fee) until November 11th at 3:00pm. Students in 2nd semester only AP classes must wait to register once that class has started and will be at the regular fee.

Did you know there's an additional step other than paying for the exam in order to get your test ordered?!?! You must be registered in College Board as well. Your AP teacher has an updated list of students in 1st semester/full year classes and whether or not you are missing one portion of this. We cannot order an exam without a student being registered with College Board for their particular exam regardless of payment made. If experiencing financial difficulties and struggle to make payment, please contact your Dean of Students as soon as possible.
